# Sector Jacksonville Sick Bay

- We handle your USCG medical administration, which consist of filling paper work, updating your Coast Guard medical profiles.
- We are a only an acute care sick bay so we have very limited capabilities to provide care.

# Health Care

- Reserve CG personnel ordered to active duty with their consent for less than thirty days are eligible for emergency treatment only. IAW COMDTINST M6000.1E CH2

# Health Care

- Only Reserve members of the reserve components who are on active duty (including active duty for training) for periods prescribed for more than 30 days are entitled to the same health care in any facility of the uniformed services as that provided for active duty members of the regular services.

# Health Care

- CG Reserve members are encouraged to review info on TRICARE Reserve Select (TRS) Health Plan. TRS is a premium-based health plan available worldwide to Selected Reserve members of the Ready Reserve and their families who qualify. TRS provides comprehensive coverage and allows you to see any TRICARE-authorized provider for care.

- All CG Reservist are encouraged to review the TriCare Dental Program. The TRICARE Dental Program is a voluntary, premium-based dental insurance plan.

# Health Care

- Reserve members who are without dental insurance and are 50 miles or more from a Coast Guard Dental Treatment Facility (DTF) can elect to call the Reserve Health Readiness Program (RHRP) Dental Screening Number at 1-888-697-4299 to schedule an appointment with a contract dentist for a screening examination. The closest DTF is in Clearwater.

# Health Care

- The USCG does not reimburse for dental examination, nor will it cover the cost of required work determined to be needed after annual dental exam.

- Must have Valid ID card.
- All items are not guaranteed to be in stock

# Periodic Health Assessments (PHA)

- PHAs are due every year.
- They can be completed 60 days prior to the last day of the members birth month to count for that year.
- Follow up for abnormal findings need to be scheduled with the members Primary Care Manager. All documentation from follow up visit needs to be submitted to Sector Jacksonville Sick Bay.
