Rochester is a sprawling four season city. A quiet and cold winter requires careful driving and dressing in layers. The winter season usually begins in late December and heads into early May. Summer time is the best season in Rochester. Great sunny weather during the day and nice warm nights make for awesome fun at the beach. Hundreds of boats come out for the summer season and line Irondequoit Bay and Lake Ontario.

Newly arriving members will go into a break-in status and complete Communication Watch Stander, Boat Crew member on 47 MLB and 25 RB-S platforms, Boarding Team Member and Ice Rescuer.

Work at the station corresponds with the weather. In the winter, preparation for the summer takes priority of daily activities. Ice Rescue is a heavy focus during the winter, with maintenance and training following closely. Living accommodations are plentiful in Rochester. There are many apartment homes within a five to ten mile radius of the station, which simplifies getting to work. Prices are reasonable with BAH.
