I checked our folders. We were notified via phone call from SECTOR shortly after 0900. We sent our first text page out to the staff at 0914, stating that a Good Sam located a body off Point Reyes.

IRT San Francisco's OPSUM, we received it that morning at 1025. Here is the entry:

SAR - POSSIBLE COLLISION-FALSE ALARM - SIX NM WEST OF POINT REYES
IC: SECTOR SAN FRANCISCO
MISLE: 361212

SITUATION: At 1715T 13 July, Station Bodega Bay responded to a possible collision between a bulk ship, the EVA DANIELSON and a fishing vessel. The EVA DANIELSON called stating they had lost contact with a fishing vessel after making passing arrangements close aboard. The container vessel feared it had run over the fishing vessel. The container vessel relocated the fishing vessel, the MARJA on radar and made contact via radio - confirmed no collision. CASE CLOSED - FALSE ALARM.

When I saw this entry, it was then I had my SARDO (LTJG [REDACTED]) question SF about it for possible correlation.

I hope this helps.
