Lisa Cook Reed Memorial Spouse Education Grants

The SPEG is supported by gift funds from the Coast Guard Foundation. Grants will be disbursed on a first-come first-served basis based on availability of funds. The Foundation Spouse Education Grant is intended to assist non-military spouses pursuing professional development courses, licensing courses, certificates, certifications, and college and graduate level degrees from a nationally or regionally accredited institution.

Eligibility: The SPEG is open to spouses of active duty enlisted personnel in pay grades E-3 through E-6. Spouses of Reservists on any type of active duty orders for at least one year in duration in the aforementioned pay grades are also eligible. Grants will be in the amount of \$500 and are limited to one payment per calendar year. Applicants can apply for this grant in advance of class dates, however **all applicants must supply proof of enrollment.**
