Instrumentation, gauges and warning lights. <i>Ref (a) Appendix B & Ref (c).</i>		
Exhaust System, leaks, hangers, damage. <i>Owner's Manual, & Ref (c)</i>		
*Tires, air pressure, tread condition, unusual wear. <i>Ref (a) Appendix B, Owner's Manual.</i>		
Spare Tire/Jack/Lug wrench. <i>Owner's Manual & Ref (c).</i>		
Wheels/studs (missing/loose). <i>Owner's Manual & Ref. (c).</i>		
Brakes (pedal action/pull) fluid level. <i>Owner's Manual & Ref. (c)</i>		
Parking brake holds to limit of traction (test). <i>Ref (a) Appendix B & Ref. (c).</i>		
Vehicle Seat & Shoulder belts system. <i>Ref (b) 10.1.2.b</i>		
Windshield (no damage in field of wipers). <i>Owner's Manual & Ref. (c).</i>		
Windshield wiper condition washer fluid level. <i>Owner's Manual & Ref. (c).</i>		
Engine oil level/Trans fluid level/P/S fluid level. <i>Owner's Manual</i>		
Truck rated 10,000lbs or greater. <i>Ref (a) Appendix C</i>		
Tires including spare less than 1/4" tread. <i>Ref. (c).</i>		
Emergency road kit (reflectors or flares). (Dependant on type and use of vehicle)		
Fire Extinguisher (mounted, inspected) if applicable.		
Accident report forms. SF-91, and SF-94. <i>Ref (a) Pg 6-4</i>		
First Aid Kit (inspect expiration dates) if applicable.
