**Subj: IMPLEMENTATION OF AREA CHANGES FOR IMMINENT DANGER PAY AND HARDSHIP DUTY PAY-LOCATION RATE CHANGES**

**Purpose** This message provides the payroll systems implementation of Imminent Danger Pay (IDP) area changes and Hardship Duty Pay-Location (HDP-L) rate and location changes prescribed in reference (a).

---

**IDP Implementation** Per reference (a), paragraph 2, effective 1 June 2014 several areas will no longer be designated IDP areas. The changes will be implemented as follows:

Stage	Description
1	PPC will shut down, effective 31 May 2014 all members receiving IDP (JUMPS segment 05) in Direct Access that have an open row or a row with a stop date that extends past 31 May 2014.
2	PPC will provide the responsible SPOs with a list of members whose IDP was stopped. Per reference (a), paragraph 3, members located in Bahrain who were receiving IDP are entitled to HDP-L effective 1 June 2014 (See HDP-L implementation on the next page). In addition, the designation of the land areas and airspace above Afghanistan and Iraq are continued.
3	SPOs must restart IDP, effective 1 June 2014, for members located in areas which remain designated in <a href="#">DoD Financial Management Regulation, 7000.14-R, Volume 7A, Chapter 10, Figure 10-1</a> (e.g. Areas not listed in reference (a), paragraph 2).

**HDP-L Implementation** Per reference (a), paragraph 3, effective 1 June 2014, Bahrain is an authorized HDP-L area and rates for several other areas increased. The changes will be implemented as follows:

<b>Stage</b>	<b>Description</b>
1	PPC will shut down effective 31 May 2014 all members receiving Hazardous Duty Pay (JUMPS segment 08) in Direct Access who are located in Saudi Arabia, Haiti, or Liberia and have an open row or a row with a stop date that extends past 31 May 2014.
2	PPC will provide the responsible SPOs with a list of members whose HDP-L was stopped.
3	SPOs must: <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Restart HDP-L at the new rate of \$150 per month, effective 1 June 2014, for members located in Saudi Arabia, Haiti, or Liberia.</li><li>2. Start HDP-L at the rate of \$50 per month, effective 1 June 2014, for members located in Bahrain.</li></ol>

**Timing** PPC will execute the Direct Access updates, described in the previous sections, following the May 2014 end-month compute on 20 May 2014. Direct Access pay entitlement rows will reflect the IDP and HDP-L stops following the data resynchronization process which is expected to be completed by 22 May 2014. PPC will e-mail rosters of personnel affected by the IDP or HDP-L stops upon completion of the data resynchronization.

**Savings  
Deposit,  
Program,  
Combat Tax  
Exclusion, and  
Combat SGLI  
Allowance**

Loss of IDP eligibility will not affect members' eligibility for participation in the Savings Deposit Program.

Current DoD policy guidance indicates that continued Combat Zone Tax Exclusions and Combat SGLI Allowance entitlements remain unaffected.
