On 26 July 1990, the Vice Commandant affirmed the suspension of Petitioner's license. Petitioner thereafter filed a timely notice of appeal to the National Transportation Safety Board. Pending the decision of the Vice Commandant, Petitioner had been granted a temporary license. By request dated 7 August 1990 Petitioner has requested a stay of the decision of the vice Commandant pursuant to 46 CFR 5.715 pending the decision of the National Transportation Safety Board.

ORDER

The effect of the Vice Commandant's decision on Appeal 2501 issued on 26 July 1990 is hereby STAYED pending the decision of the National Transportation Safety Board on Petitioner's appeal. An Officer in Charge, Marine Inspection shall issue a temporary document to Petitioner in accordance with 46 CFR 5.715, to be renewed as necessary until such time as the National Transportation Safety Board has completed its review.
