His previous assignments include Officer in Charge USCG Station San Juan, Puerto Rico; Officer in Charge USCG Motor Life Boat Station Ketchikan, Alaska (second tour); Executive Petty Officer USCGC NARWHAL; Executive Petty Officer USCGC POINT STUART; USCG Motor Life Boat Station Ketchikan (first tour); USCG Pacific Area Training Team and the USCGC CONIFER.



Master Chief Lindsey holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Organizational Leadership. He is a graduate of the U.S. Army Sergeants Major Academy, Chief Petty Officers Academy, and Senior Enlisted Command Master Chief Course. He holds an Advance Technical dive instructor rating as well as a 100GT Merchant Marine Officer's license.
