Master Chief Sulski enlisted in the Coast Guard in 1992. Upon graduation from recruit training, Master Chief Sulski reported aboard USCGC CUTTYHUNK where he advanced from Seaman Apprentice to Boatswain's Mate Third Class. In 1995, he reported for duty aboard USCGC POINT DORAN where he served as First Lieutenant, Deck Watch Officer and Boarding Officer.

In 1997 Master Chief Sulski was transferred ashore serving at Coast Guard Station Bellingham as Operations Petty Officer. In 1999, he was assigned to Coast Guard Station Marquette to assume duties as Executive Petty Officer. From April 2002 until June 2005, Master Chief Sulski returned to sea, serving aboard USCGC STEADFAST, where he was the cutter's Command Chief, Deck Watch Officer and Chief Master at Arms.



In 2005, Master Chief Sulski served as Officer in Charge, Coast Guard Station Grand Haven until May of 2010. From May 2010 through July 2013 he was assigned as Officer in Charge, Coast Guard Station Alexandria Bay. Prior to his assignment as the Command Master Chief for the Ninth Coast Guard District, Master Chief Sulski attended the United States Army Sergeants Major Academy from August 2013 through June 2014 where he graduated on Commandant's list.

Master Chief Sulski is a graduate of the U.S. Coast Guard Chief Petty Officer Academy and has earned an Associate of Arts degree in Business and a Bachelor of Arts in Organizational Management. His awards include two Coast Guard Commendation Medal, three Coast Guard Achievement Medals, seven Good Conduct Awards and numerous operational unit awards.

Master Chief Sulski is a native of Vashon Island, Washington and is married to the former Stacy Linn Drake of Casper, Wyoming. They have one daughter, Paige.
