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[Draft Merchant Mariner Credential Medical Evaluation Report Form CG-719K and CG-719 K/E Prematurely Released](#)

The Coast Guard mistakenly posted draft versions of two medical evaluation report forms (CG-719K and CG-719 K/E) on the Coast Guard Headquarters (CG-6) form database. These forms in turn linked to the National Maritime Center (NMC) forms page where they were downloaded and disseminated by numerous groups. The new medical evaluation report forms were designed to work with guidance contained in Navigation and Vessel Inspection Circular 04-08, Medical and Physical Evaluation Guidelines for Merchant Mariner Credentials. However, the forms have not been approved for use by the Office of Management and Budget (OMB).

As soon as these forms are approved they will be posted to the NMC's web site along with an information bulletin will be published with further information. Until then, mariners should continue to use the [Merchant Marine Personnel Physical Examination Report \(Form CG-719K\)](#). Applicants for entry level ratings should use the [Merchant Marine Certification of Fitness for Entry Level Ratings Form CG-719K/E](#).
