<b>Recency</b> – 90 days in the past 3 years on vessels of appropriate tonnage.	11.201	
<b>MATE OSV Restricted to Service on Liftboats</b>	<b>46 CFR</b>	
720 days of service in the deck department on vessels operating in oceans, near coastal and Great Lakes waters, <b>OF WHICH</b> 1. Service on Great Lakes and inland waters may substitute for up to 360 days of the required service; <b>AND</b> 2. 360 days of the required service must have been on vessels of more than 100 GRT	11.497  CG-CVC PL 14-03	
For endorsements restricted to liftboats, service on Liftboats will be credited 1:1 or day for day without regard to whether the liftboat was underway or elevated at the time of service.	CG-CVC PL 14-03	
<b>Renewal</b>		
Liftboat service may be used for renewal of any deck officer endorsement and will be credited day for day without regard to whether the liftboat was underway or elevated at the time of service.	CG-CVC PL 14-03	
<b>Removal of Restriction to Liftboats</b>		
Mariners seeking to remove a lifeboat restriction from their endorsement must meet the full service and training requirements for their endorsement. Service calculated to meet full requirements is calculated in accordance: Liftboat service will be credited 1:1 or day for day when the vessel is underway. Liftboat service while the vessel is elevated will be credited 1:2 (1 day of credited service for 2 days served) for up to 50% of the required service. <i>Note: Service may also be credited as noted here for any deck officer endorsement.</i>	CG-CVC PL 14-03

**Credential language:**

**National Officer Endorsements:** Mate of Offshore Supply Vessels Upon Near Coastal Waters (Or Upon Oceans -As appropriate) Restricted to Service on Liftboats.

**STCW Endorsement:** OICNW – Restricted to Service on Liftboats. (Limited to Near Coastal Voyages if applicable)

*Note: when the Liftboat restriction is removed, the limitation is replaced with “Limited to service on offshore supply vessels” unless a non-trade restricted endorsement of an equal or higher authority is held.*
