<b>50 GRT</b> – 45 days (25%) of service on vessels 26 GRT or above <b>OR</b> 90 days (50%) of service on vessels 17 GRT or above *** If the applicant has 1 day of service BEFORE March 24, 2014 on a vessel greater than 5 GRT, the MMC may be issued for 50 GRT without meeting this tonnage calculation.
