RENEWAL OF ADVANCED FIREFIGHTING After January 1, 2017		
1. Every 5 years to maintain the required standard of competence in Advanced Firefighting (VI/3), an applicant must provide: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 360 days of sea service within the past 5 years, AND, • Evidence of assessments conducted onshore for certain sections of: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Control Firefighting Operations aboard ships 2. Organize and train fire parties 3. Inspect and Service Fire-detection and extinguishing systems and equipment 4.
