<b>Grandfathering</b>		
<b>Until December 31, 2016, mariners may use some or all of the former assessments only from NVIC 01-06 to meet the equivalent assessments specified in NVIC 07-14.</b>		
<b>Limitations</b>		
Per Enclosure 3 of NVIC 07-14, based on the assessments completed, a mariner may qualify for one of the following limitations:		
" <b>Limited</b> to motor and/or gas-turbine propelled vessels only."		
" <b>Limited</b> to motor and/or gas-turbine propelled vessels without distilling plants."		
" <b>Limited</b> to motor and/or gas-turbine propelled vessels without waste-heat or auxiliary boilers."		
" <b>Limited</b> to motor and/or steam propelled vessels."		
" <b>Limited</b> to gas-turbine propelled and /or steam propelled vessels"		
" <b>Limited</b> to steam propelled vessels"		
<b>Note: If mariner completes the assessments from NVIC 01-06 convert the word "restricted" to Limited as listed in the current limitations.</b>		
<b>Note: If mariner does NOT complete any of the gas assessments, then you must remove "gas-turbine" from the limitation.</b>		
<b>Note: Utilize the crossover, MCP-WI-NMC5-87from CG Portal when completing any RFPEW file. This will help you determine the limitations.</b>
