CERTIFICATE OF DOCUMENTATION RENEWAL FEE

Effective November 10, 2014 the cost to renew Certificates of Documentation (COD) will be \$26.00. The Final Rule that established this new fee was published in the Federal Register (79 FR 47015) on August 12, 2014.

Electronic payments for Renewal and Late Renewals are now accepted through pay.gov!

Payment may also be made by credit card with accompanying CG-7042 Authorization for Credit Card Transactions or by check or money order **payable to the U.S. Coast Guard**. Please note, application fees, which includes a renewal, are non-refundable as per 46 CFR 67.500(e).

ALL CUSTOMERS MUST INCLUDE A PAYMENT OF \$26.00 PER VESSEL WITH THE CG-1280 APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL. PAYMENT MUST ACCOMPANY THE CG-1280 FOR ALL RENEWALS.

WHEN RENEWING VESSEL FLEETS, THE CG-1280 AND LIST OF VESSELS MUST BE SUBMITTED AT THE SAME TIME AS THE PAYMENT. YOU MAY NOT SUBMIT SEPARATE PAYMENTS FOR EACH VESSEL IN A FLEET.

Submissions for late renewals must be received in our office within 30 days of the date of expiration on the COD. The late fee remains unchanged at \$5.00; however the \$26.00 renewal fee (for a total of \$31.00) must be included and accompany all late submissions.
